All submissions should be written in Microsoft Word in Times New Roman, double- spaced,
size 12 font.
Please include page numbers on the manuscript.
References requirements
Authors are responsible for the accuracy and completeness of their references and for correct
text citation. Please number references in the order they appear in the text; do not alphabetize. In
text, tables, and legends, identify references with superscript Arabic numerals. References
should be placed after the punctuation.

- a. When listing references, follow AMA style and abbreviate names of journals according to the journal's list in PubMed. List all authors and/or editors up to 6; if more than 6, list the first 3 followed by "et al." For Example:
  - Magill SS, Edwards JR, Bamberg W, et al. Multistate point-prevalence survey of health care—associated infections. *N Engl J Med.* 2014; 370:1198-1208.
  - ii. Krediet AC, Kalkman CJ, Bonten MJ, Gigengack AC, Barach P.Hand-hygiene practices in the operating theatre: an observational study. *Br J Anaesth.* 2011; 107:553-558.
- b. Please include in your title page if Endnote or another software tool for references is used in your submission. If using endnote, the citation style is: "JAMA".

## **Copyrights**

Authors must submit written permission from the copyright owner (usually the publisher) to use direct quotations, tables, figures, or illustrations that have appeared elsewhere, along with complete details about the source. Any permission fees that might be required by the copyright owner are the responsibility of the authors requesting use of the borrowed material, not the APSF. Unpublished figures require permission of the author.
